A casual vacancy exists in the office of Town Councillor for Shanklin Town Council in Central Ward.

Notice is hereby given that all qualified* persons who wish to stand for Co-option to the Town Council should request application forms from the Town Clerk RFO no later than 12 noon Monday 7 October 2024. Forms will be sent out to you 8 October.

Valid nominations will be considered at the full Town Council meeting on Thursday 31 October 2024. Nominees will be asked to make a short presentation to the Town Council during the time set aside for Public Forum prior to the start of the meeting.

* Qualified persons are:

- 18 years of age or over
- A British citizen, an eligible Commonwealth citizen, a citizen of the Republic of Ireland or a qualifying EU citizen or an EU citizen with retained rights,
- Registered as a local government elector of the Town of Shanklin or,
- Have during the whole of the twelve months before nomination occupied land or premises as owner or tenant in the Town or,
- During the same period resided in the Town or within 3 miles thereof or,
- During the same period had his/her principal or only place of work in that area.

Applicants should not be disqualified from being elected by reason of any disqualification set out in Section 80 of the Local Government Act 1972, or any decision made under section 79 of the Local Government Act 2000.
